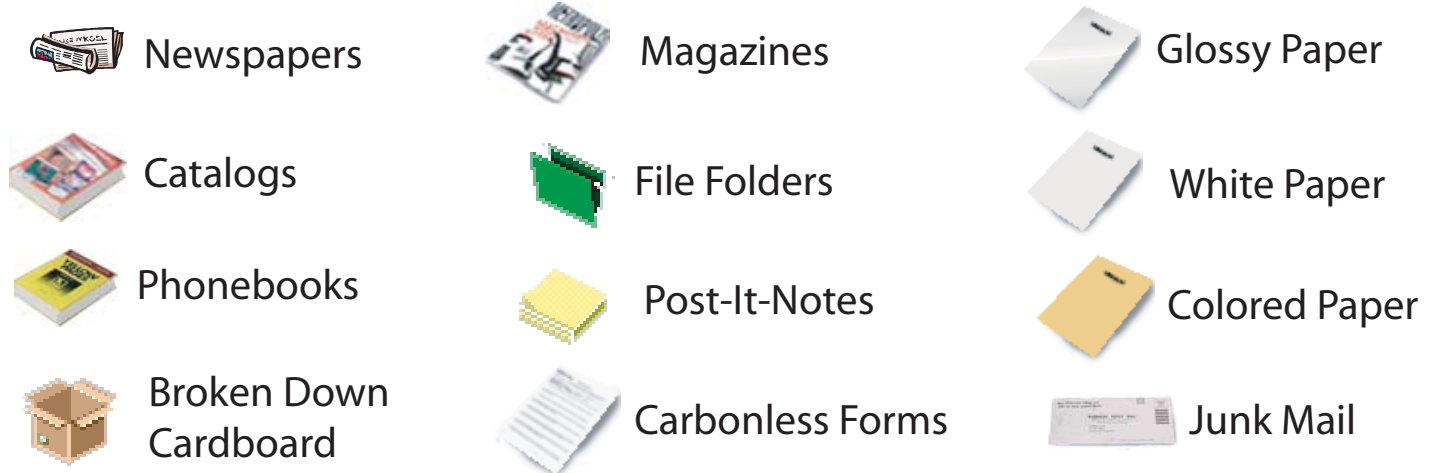


What can you recycle at MIT?

in green-top bins. Must be empty, but do not need to be cleaned.

Technotrash

Technotrash cans are unique containers located on campus.

CDs, diskettes, audio and video tapes
Cell phones, pagers, and PDAs
Rechargeable batteries

Toner Cartridges

Place in designated containers in Distributed Mail Centers (DMC's)



Batteries

Nickel-cadmium, Button and Lithium batteries.
Alkaline batteries can be disposed of in the trash.
